It also organizes workshops and seminars on quality-related themes and disseminates the proceedings across the institution. Finally, the Academic Council accords its approval to the PPRs of various programmes, completing the process of validation and readiness for implementation.

10.1 Innovations introduced during academic year

For ONLINE Mode:

1. A one-week online academic orientation programme was organized by the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) for newly admitted students to familiarize them with the Online Programme, academic structure, Learning Management System (LMS), examination system and various student support services.
2. Online mentoring sessions organized for the students of Online Programmes to address their academic queries and provide continuous academic support.
3. Regular online interaction and learner-support sessions are organized by the respective Course Coordinators and Programme Coordinators to facilitate academic guidance and resolve students' queries.
4. The students are connected through LMS, official E-mail, What Sapp, Google Classroom, social media platforms and other approved digital communication channels for timely academic and administrative support.
5. Online examinations are conducted for Online Programmes as per the applicable University and UGC guidelines, including theory, practical and viva-voce examinations wherever applicable.
6. Assignments are submitted and evaluated through the online portal, providing a systematic and technology-enabled mechanism for continuous assessment.
7. A three-tier student Grievance Redressal Mechanism has been activated to facilitate timely resolution of academic, examination, LMS and other student-related grievances.
8. The admission criteria, academic standards and pass/fail criteria of the Online Programmes are maintained in accordance with the applicable University rules and UGC guidelines.
9. The schemes, syllabi and course curricula of the Online Programmes are developed and implemented at par with the prescribed academic standards of the University.
10. The Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) offers Online Programmes at undergraduate and postgraduate levels, providing learners with flexible and technology-enabled access to higher education.
11. The Centre for Distance and Online Education has introduced Online programmes/courses for the benefit of learners, providing flexible learning opportunities through digital platforms.
12. The Self-Learning Materials (SLMs) and other digital learning resources are digitized and uploaded on the University website/Learning Management System (LMS), ensuring easy and convenient access to learners enrolled in Online Programmes.
13. The Online admission process facilitates learners from different parts of India and abroad to apply and enroll in the Online Programmes through a transparent and technology-enabled admission system.
14. The Centre for Distance and Online Education implements the four-quadrant approach for its Online Programmes, comprising E-Content, E-Tutorial, E-Assessment and Discussion Forum, in accordance with the applicable UGC Regulations.
15. Technology-enabled student support services are provided through the LMS and other digital platforms, including access to course content, academic announcements, assignments, assessments, examination-related information and other important academic activities.
16. The Centre for Distance and Online Education is offering job-oriented Online Programmes/courses, including programmes in areas such as Management and Commerce, to provide learners with flexible and career-oriented higher education opportunities.

10.2 Best Practices of the HEI

In the last five years, the following are the improvement/updation w.r.t. functioning and results of CDOE.

1. Student counselling regarding Online Education and various Online Programmes is being provided from time to time to make the students aware about the programmes, academic activities and available student support services.
